

2019-2021 STIP - CULVERTS 100% LIST: ODOT REGION 1

Updated 2/22/2017

The Culvert program provides funding for rehabilitating and replacing culverts which fall into one of four focused areas: (1) Large (6 to 20 foot span) Culverts on any highway; (2) Culverts of any size located on ODOT Priority Routes; (3) High Priority Fish Passage Barriers (as defined by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife); and (4) Major Culvert Maintenance Program which is used deliver small culvert repair projects on all routes. Currently there is limited funding available to replace small culverts on non-Priority Routes.
